

Scottish Student Sport (SSS) Terms & Conditions

1. Students are eligible to participate in student categories within SSS events if they:
 - Are currently matriculated at a Scottish University or College in the current academic year
 - Have completed/are sitting at least 60 credits within the current academic year
 - Are insured by their institution
 - Their university or college is an affiliated member of SSS
 - Aged 16 years or older

Some SSS events may offer Guest categories for non-students, alumni or students who fall outside of the above criteria. The entry information for each event will specify whether this Guest category is available or not, but any queries regarding eligibility should be directed to the Events Coordinator on jess@scottishstudentsport.com

2. Where an institution does not make payment for SSS events it is the responsibility of the individual/team participating in that event to make full payment.
3. If an individual/ team pulls out of an event **after the stated event entry deadline** they will still be charged – except in exceptional circumstances. For example, SSS decides to cancel an event due to unprecedented circumstances, the institution and or individual will receive a full refund.
4. If an individual/ team pulls out of an event **before the stated event entry deadline** they will receive a refund, however, they will be charged a card processing fee.
5. Individuals participating in SSS events consent to their photograph being taken or being video recorded, by a representative of Scottish Student Sport.

These photographic images/videos may be used in promotional materials for SSS, both in print and digital media - including social media. Images/videos may be shared within the education sector for promotional materials both in print and digital media - including social media. Consent will remain valid until an individual advises us otherwise. Our Business Manager should be contacted on totty@scottishstudentsport.com should participants not wish for their photograph not to be taken during our events.

Individuals entering SSS events consent that any intellectual property, including copyright and image rights, which arises in the photograph(s)/videos belongs to SSS.

6. Individuals participate in SSS events at their own risk and no responsibility whatsoever shall be attached to any event sponsors, directors or any person involved in the organisation of the



event for any injury, accidents, loss or damage suffered by an individual in, or by reason of the event, however such may be caused.

7. In regards to illness or injury:

- Illness - is it the responsibility of the student, official or individual taking part not to attend the event should they feel unwell (whether determined to have COVID-19 or another illness) to avoid risk of transmission to others. In this instance the individual should notify the Event Organiser as soon as possible that they are unable to attend. No refunds will be provided in the case of withdrawal due to illness
- Injury - If a student, official or individual taking part is no longer able to participate due to injury, and the entry deadline has passed, no refunds will be provided
