Description of Event: Welcome back to another year of student shinty, it's time to pick up your camans and join Scottish Student Sport in our shinty festival to welcome back returning players and new faces!

Registration: 9.30am till 9.50am. Registration is to be completed by team captains, by reporting to Callum on the morning. All teams should also have a completed team sheet on Playwaze by 11pm on Friday 3rd October.

Captain's meeting: All captains should meet at 9.45am for a briefing before fixtures begin.

Equipment Regulations: All players must ensure that shin guards are worn and we strongly advise helmets are worn for matches. If you will not be wearing a helmet, this must be declared at registration and you must provide a helmet waiver.

Draw/Format: Round Robin, followed by Finals. Information will be given on the day

Teams: Teams should be an even mix of experience and inexperienced players, and a maximum of 8 (6 players and 2 subs)

- An 'experienced' player is someone who has played shinty (for a club or student club) for more than 2 years
- An 'inexperienced player' is someone who has played shinty for less than 2 years



Warm Up: Warm-up will take place on the pitch during the registration time from 0930-1000

Medals and Ceremony: There are no medals awarded in this event

Changing Room access: There will be one Men's and one Women's changing room available, but please arrive ready to play

Withdrawal Policy: If you no longer intend to participate, please contact the event organiser as soon as possible. <u>SSS Terms and Conditions</u> will have been sent with your booking confirmation email so please refer to this for information on the SSS Refund Policy.
