Time commitment:	<p>Minimum 3-4 meetings per year with further opportunities outside of meetings.</p> <p>The minimum duration of the role is 1 year, however there is scope to stand for a longer or shorter period at the discretion of SSS. Following the 1 year mark there may be another opportunity to stand for this, or another, role on the development group at the agreement of all parties.</p>
Role description:	<p>The Basketball Development Group has been established to guide the work of SSS in Basketball.</p> <p>As a student rep you will be responsible for ensuring the views of clubs are raised at the Development Group. We are looking to recruit students to represent both men's and women's basketball.</p> <p>You will assist in ensuring communication channels between the Development Group and clubs is appropriate and regular.</p> <p>Assist in the organisation of captains meetings throughout the year.</p> <p>As a member, you will work with the rest of the group to create and deliver a development plan across a range of areas including competition, workforce, club development, and publicity.</p> <p>You will help to set policy for basketball and may be asked to lead on any specific projects being delivered at the time.</p> <p>Overall, you will represent the interests of all member institutions and student clubs to improve basketball for students in Scotland.</p>
Main tasks:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Communicate regularly with student clubs • Contribute to generation of basketball Sport Development Plan • Work within group to identify key areas of work for coming year • Drive specific outcomes as agreed by Chair and Development Group • Gather feedback from student clubs and member institutions on Development Group areas of work • Develop sport specific policy to improve student experience across all relevant areas of SSS work
