Role Description:	<p>The Volleyball Development Group/Commission has been established to guide the work of Scottish Student Sport (SSS) in Volleyball.</p> <p>Supporting the development and delivery of SSS' <i>Reffin' Brilliant</i> and <i>Coachin' Brilliant</i> programmes.</p> <p>You will communicate with student clubs to help promote any workforce opportunities and collect feedback where appropriate.</p> <p>Work with student clubs to identify barriers around accessing coaching or officiating courses.</p> <p>There will be an opportunity to work closely with SS Volleyball Development Group/Commission and Scottish Volleyball Association (SVA) to develop workforce development opportunities in line with the SSS & SVA Partnership Agreement.</p> <p>As a member, you will work with the rest of the group to create and deliver a workforce development plan as part of the encompassing SS Volleyball Sport Development Plan.</p> <p>You will help to set policy for Volleyball and may be asked to lead on any specific projects being delivered at the time.</p> <p>Overall, you will represent the interests of all member institutions and student clubs to improve Volleyball for students in Scotland.</p>
