Finalists' Brief

Date: Wednesday 11th March 2026

Venue: [Saints Sport](#), University Park, St Leonard's Rd, St Andrews KY16 9DY

Registration: All teams must register at the at the outside registration tent, beside the 3G pitch, at least one hour before the fixture.

Team lines: Please submit a written team line to registration on the day, using the regular BUCS template.

Warm Up: Teams will have an allocated warm-up time on their match area at least 30 minutes before the start time, depending on its prior use and any equipment changeovers required. Please ensure your teams bring their own warm up equipment. The match area and these timings are detailed on the fixture list document.

Changing Rooms: Changing rooms will be available. The allocation will be confirmed at registration.

Kit colours: Please ensure teams communicate with the opposition, to avoid kit clashes. The attached fixture list document and BUCS Play note who is the assigned home/away team.

Parking: Parking on site is limited and is not suitable for vehicles larger than a minibus. Can we please ask all teams to use the Bells Brae carpark, KY16 9BY. Please see map attached for directions on how to get there.

Medal Presentation: All medal presentations will take place immediately following the fixture. Medals will be presented to both teams, with SSS staff/volunteers on hand to direct teams to this area. A reminder that trophy engravings are the privilege of the winning team.

Refreshments: There is a café on site for team and spectator use. Additional shops are approx. a 10 minute walk away, if required. There are multiple water fountains on site, so please bring reusable water bottles to use on the day.

Conference Finals Merch: SSS x Canterbury will be selling customised merch on the day so be sure to check out the stall before limited stock runs out!

Mascot Race: All Sabbatical Officers are invited to compete in the mascot race at 2.40pm on the 3G pitch. Please ensure you are dressed and ready to run by this time. If yer no a sabb, yer no racing.

Spectators are welcome! However, please be mindful that all institution staff are responsible for your own spectators. We appreciate support in enforcing the venue's zero-tolerance on alcohol consumption.
